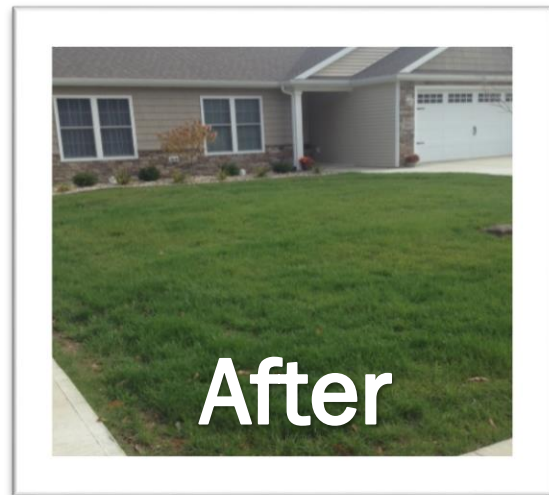
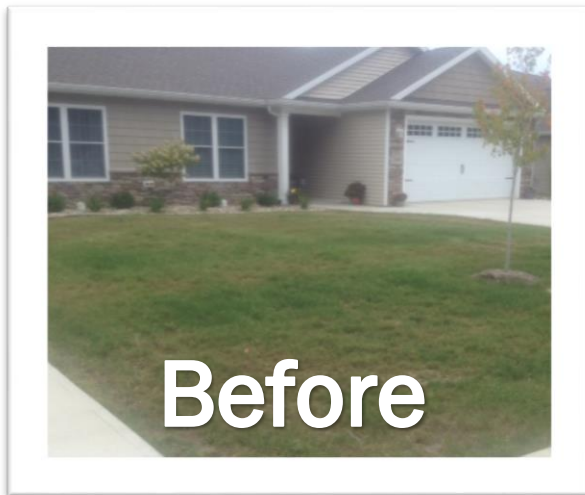

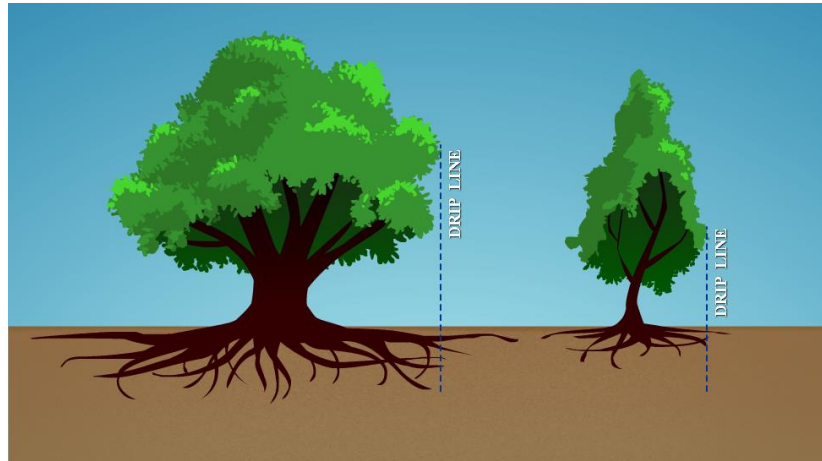
- I was called back after several years to apply more of the ODP to parts of an orchard that had not previously had any product applied. The orchardist could not believe the difference in the tree health!

General ODP Application Instructions

Use 2 tablespoons (1 ounce) per gallon of water. It may be mixed in a watering can, tank sprayer, or in irrigation systems. Apply directly to the soil in containers or inside of the drip-line for larger in-ground plants.

What is a drip line? In general, a drip line is the area defined by the outermost circumference of a tree canopy where water drips from and onto the ground. See the example below.
